001: It's in the Box

Proficiency Level: Intermediate

Kit Cost: \$85

Ground: Mono canvas, 18 ct

Design Size: 5" x 5"

Your eyes are awaiting a surprise when you peer into a box for the first time, especially if you don't know what is inside. This box represents a sparkling gem, using a monochromatic green color scheme of contrasting values.

In this class we will focus on color values and dimensional stitching, incorporating five different types of stitches. When using different values of a color you can illustrate a visual effect to one's eye. Also, by adding layers to your stitches the piece will appear to be dimensional.

Color values and dimension will be demonstrated by using some over-dyed threads and hidden or exposed padded stitches. This piece will be stitched on 18 count white mono canvas and will be a 5-inch square which will be finished as a jewelry box lid.
